

How To Earn Hundreds of Pounds From Cashback Websites

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Introduction

I've earned hundreds of pounds from cashback websites over the last 12 months and I want to teach you how to do the same. It's really easy and only requires a small amount of your time so kick back, read this short report through to the end and start making money.

How Cashback Websites Work

For years, the marketing departments of companies have been investing huge sums of money in the advertisement and promotion of their products. Some of the marketing budget goes to third parties who will promote the company's products in exchange for a commission each time they refer a new customer.

Then, some bright spark from one of these third-party companies had the idea that if they **shared the commission with the purchaser**, said purchaser would have an incentive to be referred. **And so, the cashback website was born.**

When you visit a cashback website, you will see a list of companies. Each of the companies listed has an arrangement with the cashback website to **pay them either a set fee or percentage of revenue** each time they refer a new customer. Against each of the companies is how much you, as a customer, can earn and what you have to do to earn it. Once you've decided on the offer(s) you want to take up, sign up for the cashback website, login to it and click on the special link to the merchant. Whilst making the transaction, the cashback website will track it and credit your account with the cashback.

*For example, at the time of writing, AA Motor insurance are offering £35 cashback to customers that take out their car insurance with them after visiting the cashback website **Greasy Palm**. The AA have partnered with **Greasy Palm** to sell their insurance and have probably offered **Greasy Palm** something like £50 for each new client they refer. By giving the consumer £35 and keeping the remaining £15 for themselves, **Greasy Palm** create an incentive for customers to buy through them.*

As well as making savings on stuff that you buy, there are also methods of actually **making money using cashback websites**.

How to Make Money with Cashback Websites

Earning money from cashback websites can be split into three main categories; Free Signups, Financial Products and Gambling.

Free Signups simply require you to do something for free and get paid for it. What you have to do varies but is usually either signing up for something or clicking on an Internet link. The sums of cashback you can earn are usually quite small (usually less than £3) but they are very quick and easy to do.

*For example, at the time of writing, **RPoints** are offering £2.50 (or 250 points, as they call it) if you sign up with Microsoft Office Live to get a free website. It doesn't cost anything except 10 minutes of your time and you get £2.50 for doing it.*

Financial Products usually take a little longer to do but the cashback is bigger and it doesn't cost you anything other than time. By financial products, I mean Credit Cards, Current Accounts and Savings Accounts - or anything financial that is free to set up.

*For example, at the time of writing, **Free Fivers** will give you a whopping £25 when you get accepted for an American Express Nectar Card. You don't even have to use it - simply close the credit card account after receiving the cashback!*

A note of caution: Every time you apply for financial products such as credit cards, the provider will do a search of your credit record to make sure you're keeping up with repayments. If they see you've been making a lot of applications, it could prevent you from being accepted and hence you won't get any cashback. So, don't go overboard and apply for all the credit cards you can find – from my experience I've found it should be okay to apply every month or two.

Finally **Gambling Websites** can be a great little earner. Gambling websites include online bookmakers, bingo rooms, casinos and poker rooms. You usually have to bet some money to earn the cashback, so there is an initial outlay but the cashback you earn is very often more than your costs.

*For example, at the time of writing, **Quidco** is offering £25 cashback when you join Coral bookmakers and make a £10 bet. Simple math shows that as soon as you've put your bet on, you're £15 up whether you win or not! If you do win the wager, then that's a bonus. As an additional bonus, Coral even give you an extra £10 bet for free. Easy Money.*

Start Making Money

So, now you know how easy it is, get yourself going and start earning yourself some money. Some have said that this is the most difficult part of this strategy. Don't hang about – DO IT NOW. Good Luck :)
